FREE DROP-OFF MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY!!

Recycling your outdated/unwanted electronic equipment is a great way to keep recyclable materials out of our landfills and protect our environment.

Wilmington residents may drop off electronics for recycling at the DPW Administration Building at 115 Andover Street Monday through Friday between 8 AM and 3 PM.

You will need to show proof of residency to participate in this program.

To schedule pick-up of a TV or computer monitor, residents must buy a sticker (\$10 each) at the Treasurer/Collector's Office at the Town Hall. You will be placed on a list for pick-up at curbside.
