



BOARD OF HEALTH
MINUTES
October 3, 2017

The Board of Health held a meeting in Room 9 at the Town Hall, 121 Glen Road, Wilmington, MA. The meeting was called to order at 5:40 p.m. Present were, Elizabeth Sabounjian, Dr. Daniel King, Dr. Jane Williams and Shelly Newhouse, Director of Public Health. The next regularly scheduled Board of Health meeting will be October 17, 2017 at 5:30 p.m. in Room 9 at the Town Hall, 121 Glen Road, Wilmington, MA.

The Board reviewed and approved the September 19, 2017 minutes

The Board reviewed the most recent food inspection reports.

New Business

13 Muse Avenue

Jonathan Langone's attorney contacted Town Counsel, Lou Ross regarding the Board's vote to revoke Mr. Langone's septic installer license. After review, Town Counsel advised that the Board should rescind the vote of September 19, 2017 and reinstate his installer's license. We would likely lose in court if challenged. Dr. King motioned to rescind the vote taken on September 19, 2017 and reinstate Mr. Langone's septic installers license effective immediately, Dr. Williams, second, voted 3-0. The Board asked the Director to look into regulation changes that would allow the Board to possibly revoke licenses if a person or firm violates other local, state and/or federal regulations. Abutter, Lori Flaherty, was in attendance and asked if the Board could file a complaint with the Construction Supervisors License Board against Mr. Langone's license. The Director explained that she had already done that and the CSL Board called to explain the as the Health Director she could not file the complaint. A complaint has to come from the municipal building inspector. Dr. Williams motioned that a formal request be brought to the Building Inspector asking him to file a complaint with the CSL Board against Mr. Langone's license, Dr. King seconded, voted 3-0.
