



BOARD OF HEALTH
March 19, 2019

The Board of Health held a meeting in Room 9 at the Town Hall, 121 Glen Road, Wilmington, MA. The meeting was called to order at 5:45 p.m. Present were, Elizabeth Sabounjian, Dr. Jane Williams, Dr. Daniel King and Shelly Newhouse, Director of Public Health. The next regularly scheduled Board of Health meeting will be April 6, 2019 at 5:30 p.m. in Room 9 at the Town Hall, 121 Glen Road, Wilmington, MA.

The Board reviewed and approved the minutes from January 15, 2019 and March 5, 2019.

The Board reviewed the most recent food inspection reports. The Director reported that Starbucks was issued a fine in the amount of \$300.00 for repeated dumpster violations.

New Business

Josie's Bakery, 2 Lowell Street – floor plan

Josie's Bakery will be occupying the old Edible Arrangements space. Most of the equipment is already there and they are bringing in some stand mixers and other miscellaneous bakery products. Dr. Williams motioned to approve the floor plan, Dr. King, seconded, voted 3-0.

Pie Me Over, 217 Main Street – floor plan

Pie Me Over, a meat, poultry and dessert pie establishment will be occupying the former Fantastic Sam's space. All new equipment, lighting, walls and flooring will need to be fit up. Dr. Williams motioned to approve the floor plan, Dr. King, seconded, voted 3-0.

18 Faulkner Avenue- application for 4 chickens

The applicant, Derek Smith is applying for an animal permit to have 4 chickens. The Director presented the Board with a completed application and google earth view of the property. No neighbors had any comments. The animal control officer gave a favorable recommendation. Dr. King, motioned to approve the application, Dr. Williams seconded, voted 3-0.
