Day 1: This evening depart on your non-stop jet service to Reykjavik, Iceland.

Day 2: After an early morning arrival your local tour director will greet you at the airport. Discover Iceland's capital city of Reykjavik on a guided tour. You'll see the old town, shopping districts, Parliament House, Hofdi House and Hallgrim's Church. Later, check into the quaint Center Hotel Plaza ideally located in Reykjavik's downtown area full of shops, restaurants and nightlife. A buffet dinner is included at the Restaurant Reykjavik. (D)



Day 3: This morning enjoy breakfast before a fabulous day of touring. Today discover the "Golden Circle" which highlights many of Iceland's natural wonders and historic sites. Explore Thingvellir National Park where the oldest existing parliament in the world first met in 930 AD. The park also features the geologically significant Mid - Atlantic Ridge where the tectonic plates divide Europe and North America. Continue to the amazing hot springs of Geysir and marvel at the two-tiered Gullfoss Waterfall. Later view a demonstration at Fridheimar Icelandic Horse Farm as well as an energy plant that generates electricity and hot water by utilizing geothermal water and steam. This evening enjoy a thrilling opportunity to view one of nature's most dazzling light displays...The Northern Lights. (If weather is inclement, this will be moved to another day in the itinerary). (B)

Day 4: Today we'll tour Iceland's beautiful South Coast. You'll have the opportunity to stand behind the plummeting Seljalandsfoss waterfall (weather permitting) and visit a wool factory. Explore the charming village of Vik surrounded by high bird cliffs as well as its famed black sand beaches. Explore the popular Skogar Museum, one of the best folklore museums in the country featuring old houses made of turf. Lastly you'll have the opportunity to gaze at Selheimajokull Glacier before returning back to your hotel. (B)



Day 5: Your whole day is free to do as you please. The downtown area of Reykjavik is Scandinavia in miniature. The capital city is awash with bold colors and filled with espresso cafes, quaint boutiques, tasteful shops, fabulous restaurants, art galleries and museums. Your tour director will be on hand to offer optional tours such as whale watching or an adventure jeep tour. This evening a sit-down dinner will be included at Kopar Restaurant. (B,D)

Day 6: Today journey to Reykjanes Peninsula, home of the famed Blue Lagoon, a unique geothermal spa located in the middle of a lava field. Relax in the warm, mineral rich water that is sure to rejuvenate the body and the spirit (towels will be provided). Feeling refreshed, you depart for your return flight home. (B)

Federal Law: Federal law forbids carriage of hazardous materials such as aerosols, fireworks, lithium batteries and flammable liquids aboard the aircraft in your checked or carry-on baggage. A violation can result in 5 years imprisonment and penalties of \$250,000 or more. Activity Level: The level of activity and amount of walking varies from tour to tour. Here at Conway Tours we do our best to evaluate each tour program with an easy to use scale. The Activity Level for this tour is:



1 Easy – This requires minimal physical activity, such as some stairs, boarding the motorcoach and walking to hotel and dining areas.

2 Moderate – This requires some physical activity, such as some walking during tours, the possibility of climbing stairs, and walking some distances.

3 Active – This requires participants to be in reasonably good health to fully enjoy all experiences. For example, walking tours, walking on uneven surfaces, periods of standing and days may be longer. We do not recommend this type of tour for individuals who use either a walker or wheelchair.
