# Town of Wilmington Water & Sewer Commission July 21, 2016 Meeting

The Water and Sewer Commission met on July 21, 2016 in Room 9 at the Town Hall. The meeting was called to order at 5:32 PM. Present were Chairman Joseph Balliro, Commissioner George Allan, Commissioner Robert LaVita, Utility & Business Manager Joseph Lobao, and Recording Secretary Diane Forest.

#### **Monthly Report**

The monthly report for June was reviewed by the Commission.

#### 2" Water Main Replacement Update

The 2" water main replacement on Kilby Street is complete. 850' of 2" water main was replaced with 8" main. On Monday, crews will begin 2" water main replacement on Pine Avenue. 320' of 2" main will be replaced with 8" main and 1 hydrant will be installed. This project will take approximately a month and a half to complete.

#### **Drought Advisory Watch**

On July 8, 2016, The Department of Environmental Protection issued a drought watch and drought advisory for many parts of the state of Massachusetts. Mr. Lobao informed the Commission that Wilmington is on the 3<sup>rd</sup> level of the 5 levels. The current water use restrictions will remain in full force and effect unless otherwise posted.

#### 2015 Consumer Confidence Report

The 2015 Consumer Confidence Report was submitted to the Commission for review. The bulk of the report is completed by the Massachusetts Water Resource Authority, while Wilmington specific information is provided by the Wilmington Water Department. All requirements for the CCR have been met.

### **Lead & Copper Sampling Rule - 2016**

The required water samples had been collected and submitted to the laboratory for lead and copper analysis as required by the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection Agency (DEP). All results indicated that lead and copper levels are below the action levels set by the DEP and the Federal Environmental Protection Agency.

The Commission was given a copy of the Water Department Rules & Regulations for input on implementation of updates. The Rules & Regulations will be reviewed by the Commission & staff.
