

The concept is that at 10:00a.m. in each local time zone worldwide, people are asked to practice Tai Chi and send out positive energy to heal the world. There will be over 80 nations and hundreds of cities involved. The motto is: "One World ... One Breath".

Oriental Healing Arts Association is celebrating this event in Massachusetts this year by gathering at the Wilmington Town Common, Church & Middlesex Ave, Wilmington, MA 01887.
