



#### SECTION 3A HOUSING REQUIREMENT & PROPOSED ZONING

When: Monday, December 11, 2023 at 1:00PM
Where: Senior Center

The Town of Wilmington is required by the new Section 3A of the Commonwealth's Zoning Act to create a new zoning district that allows for at least 1,248 units of multi-family housing units. The new zoning must be



in place by the end of 2024. Public input from the online survey led to the proposed draft zoning district, which will be presented at the May 2024 Annual Town Meeting. The proposed district includes sections of West Street, Main Street and Deming Way. Please join Valerie Gingrich, Director of Planning & Conservation, and Jayne Wierzbicki, Planner/Economic Development Coordinator to learn more about the Section 3A housing requirement and the proposed zoning that will be presented for a vote at the 2024 Annual Town Meeting.





The Community Teamwork, Inc. Fuel Assistance Program is available to new applicants starting October 1, 2023. Fuel Assistance can help pay part of your home's winter heating bill.

This program begins on November 1, 2023. Any Wilmington resident who is 60 years or older in need of fuel assistance, please call the center

to set up your appointment for assistance in the application process with Terri or Laura at 978-657-7595.

#### NEW SENIOR CENTER UPDATE

The Senior Center Building Committee met on Wednesday, November 8 at the Town Hall to receive a project update and review the project schedule.

- The site has been cleared of all trees and stumps within the project limits. The trees and stumps are being recycled into lumber and other wood products. The construction crew has been bringing in material to help level the area to the desired grade. Erosion control measures are in place and a construction fence has been installed around the work area. The construction trailers are on site.
- Excavation has begun for the concrete foundations. The forming for the foundations will start before the end of November with the concrete being poured over the next several months. The installation of site utilities is scheduled to begin by December 1. Work will continue on site as the weather allows.
  - The construction team meets on a weekly basis at the site.

The next meeting of the Senior Center Building Committee will be in January on a date to be determined. The public is reminded that this is an active construction site and to stay outside the construction fence; safety is a priority.
