

#### **ELDER CARE ATTORNEY**







People who qualify will no longer have Medicare Part B, which is currently \$164.90 a month, taken out of their Social Security check. Assets include all bank accounts, CD's, stocks, bonds, and mutual funds. Your home and one car do not count as assets. If your income and assets are under the limits listed below call the center with any questions about the program or to make an appointment with Patti Meehan.

- Single Gross Monthly Income Limit \$2,734 (\$32,808 Yearly)
- Married Asset Limit \$27,260
