

It's that time of year again! If you have a Medicare Prescription Drug Plan or a Medicare Advantage Plan (HMO, PPO), you should expect information from your plan by the end of September.



This information is important because it explains changes in your plan for 2020. During Medicare Open Enrollment

(October 15 - December 7), you will have a chance to CHANGE your plan for next year. SHINE Counselors can help you understand your plan changes, as well as other options you may have. Call early to get a SHINE appointment during Open Enrollment!

# Why is the Fluzone High-Dose Flu Vaccine better for people 65 years old?


