

BOOK CLUB




The Book Club meets on the 4th Monday of the month at 1:30PM.


INDOOR CORNHOLE

UPDATE ON NEW SENIOR CENTER PROJECT

- The Senior Center Building Committee had a meeting on September 20 at the Town Hall at 6 PM. The main topic was the discussion of the bids received from the General Contractors on September 15. The discussion was led by our OPM who made a slide presentation. There were 5 bids received. The lowest bid was \$16,857,000 submitted by J & J Contractors, Inc. of Billerica, Ma. The bids were discussed along with the project budget. Our OPM explained how the budget and cost estimates were prepared prior to last November's Special Town Meeting. The original budget carried an inflation factor of 7%. The OPM prepared a graph showing the cost of municipal building projects in Massachusetts. It showed the recent rate of inflation for municipal projects was nearly 20%. Following a review of the budget, it was determined that to award the project to the low bidder, it would require an additional \$1.8 million. After discussing various options to obtain the additional money, it was decided to transfer that amount from the grant funds received by the town under the federal American Rescue Plan Act. This transfer requires approval of the Select Board.
- At its meeting on Monday September 25, the Select Board listened to a presentation from Senior Center Building Committee and the OPM on the project financing. Following a discussion, the Select Board voted unanimously to authorize the transfer of \$1.8 million from the American Rescue Plan Act to the Senior Center Building project.
- With sufficient funds now available, the town will be able to sign a construction contract with the low bidder within a couple of weeks. Soon thereafter, we will be having a Ground Breaking at the project site and actual construction will begin.
- The Senior Center Building Committee has a meeting tentatively scheduled for Wednesday October 11 at 6 PM at the Town Hall.

WE DID IT! Thank you to everyone who was with us on this long and winding road to a new Senior Center. It took a long time and there were some bumps in the road along the way but we preserved and now we are ready to begin a new chapter for Wilmington Seniors.
