# Medicare Open Enrollment Information

It's that time of year again! If you have a Medicare Prescription Drug Plan or a Medicare Advantage Plan (HMO, PPO), You should expect information from your plan by the end of September. This information is important because it explains changes in your plan for 2018. During Medicare Open Enrollment (October 15 - December 7), you will have a chance to CHANGE your plan for next year. SHINE Counselors can help you understand your plan changes, as well as other options you may have. To schedule a SHINE appointment, call the senior center or 1-800-AGE-INFO (1-800-243-4636) ... then press or say 3. If you get the SHINE answering machine, leave your name and number. A counselor will call you back, as soon as possible. Trained SHINE counselors offer free, confidential counseling on all aspects of Medicare and related health insurance programs. Call early to receive a pre-enrollment form and make that appointment... and bring your Medicare and insurance cards and complete list of your medications. Call early to get a SHINE appointment during Open Enrollment!
