First Annual Electronics Recycling Event on September 22, 2018

It's that time of year again! If you are enrolled in a Medicare Prescription Drug Plan or a Medicare Advantage Plan (HMO/ PPO), expect an information packet from <u>your plan</u> by the end of September. It is important to **understand** and **save** this information: it explains the changes in your plan for 2019. <u>Premiums, deductibles, co-pays, and the drugs covered by your plan can change significantly!</u>

During Medicare Open Enrollment, you can adjust your plan for next year. SHINE Counselors help you understand *your* plan changes as well as *other options* you may have. Call now to discuss your insurance questions, schedule your SHINE phone or face-to-face appointment, or learn about group meetings during the Open Enrollment from **October 15 through December 7**th!

Recording a Declaration of Homestead at the Registry of Deeds protects your home from creditors. Register Howe will explain how this valuable law works and will have blank Homestead forms for anyone who wishes to file one (the recording fee is \$35, cash or check). He will also discuss and answer questions about common real estate issues such as trusts, joint ownership of property, and mortgages.
