

### BOARD OF HEALTH January 17, 2023

The meeting was in Room 5 of the Town hall and was called to order at 5:35 p.m. Present were Chairman Elizabeth Sabounjian, Dr. Daniel King, Dr. Jane Williams and Director of Public Health, Shelly Newhouse. Our next regularly scheduled meeting will be on February 7, 2023.

The Board reviewed and approved the minutes of December 20, 2022.

The Board reviewed the most recent food inspection reports. The Director updated the Board on new food establishment permits, Code 1 BBQ and Dollar General.

#### **New Business**

#### T5 Betterment -15 Burt Road

The Board reviewed a T5 Betterment in the amount of \$40,405.00 for Maria Harrison. Dr. King motioned to approve the T5 Betterment, Dr. Williams, seconded, voted 3-0.

# Public Hearing Smoking and tobacco regulations Section 8

The Chairman opened the public hearing at 5:45 p.m. The Director presented the Board with the proposed changes to the regulations as outlined below.

Electronic Nicotine Delivery System: means an electronic device, whether for one-time use or reusable, that can be used to deliver nicotine or another substance to a person inhaling from the device including, but not limited to, electronic cigarettes, electronic cigars, electronic cigarillos, electronic pipes, vaping pens, hookah pens and other similar devices that rely on vaporization or aerosolization, This term shall include such devices whether they are manufactured or marketed and sold as e-cigarettes, e-cigars, e-pipes or under any other product name provided, however, that "electronic nicotine delivery system" shall also include any noncombustible liquid or gel that is manufactured into a finished product for use in such electronic device; provided further, that "electronic nicotine delivery system" shall also include any component, part, or accessory of a device used during the operation of the device even if the part or accessory was sold separately; provided further, that "electronic nicotine delivery system" shall not include a product that has been approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration for the sale of or use as a tobacco cessation product or for other medical purposes and is marketed and sold or prescribed exclusively for that approved 105 CMR: DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH purpose.

No comments were submitted.

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Dr. King motioned to approve the proposed changes to Section 8 Smoking and Tobacco Regulations of the Wilmington Board of Health Regulations, Dr. Williams, seconded, voted 3-0.

Dr. Williams motioned to close the public hearing, Dr. King, seconded, voted 3-0.

The Director presented the Board with the calendar year 2022 statistical information. These figures will go into the 2022 Annual report.

Dr. King motioned to adjourn the meeting at 6:10 p.m., Dr. Williams seconded, voted 3-0.
