



BOARD OF HEALTH
MINUTES
February 2, 2016

The Board of Health held a meeting in Room 9 at the Town Hall, 121 Glen Road, Wilmington, MA. The meeting was called to order at 5:45 p.m. Present were Elizabeth Sabounjian, Dr. James Ficociello, and Shelly Newhouse, Director of Public Health. The Board approved the January 5, 2016 minutes.

The Board reviewed and approved the most recent food inspections. The Director updated the Board regarding 362 Middlesex Avenue. The property will be torn down this week. There are no plans to re build as of now, but expecting something this year.

Animal Control Inspector

The Town has hired a new animal control/inspector, Chris Sullivan. Mr. Sullivan was a dispatcher for the Town for 6 years. He will come to the next meeting for introductions.

Speedway renovation

Speedway, the former Hess Gas Station submitted renovation plans for review. The store will be closed until renovations are complete. This will still be a retail food establishment with no food preparation on site. Dr. Ficociello made motion to approve the floor plans, Ms. Sabounjian seconded, voted 2-0.


Public Information Request
