ABOUT THE PROPERTY

Located along Lubbers Brook, the woods are dominated by stands of white pines. Red swamp maples flank the brook and are especially attractive in the fall. A ridge running perpendicular to Lubbers Brook provides views over the wetlands. The site is a former cranberry bog and at one time the earthen dams were used to control flow in and out of the bogs.

ACCESS & PARKING

Parking and trail access at the cul-de-sac on Blanchard Rd.
Additional trail access from the east end of Cambridge Ave.
