DAY 1: DETROIT - DEARBORN

Meet your Tour Director and transfer from Wilmington to Logan Airport for your flight to Detroit. Upon arrival, transfer to the Dearborn area and check into your hotel for a two-night stay. Enjoy a welcome dinner this evening with your fellow travelers. X (D) Overnight: Dearborn, MI area

DAY 2: DEARBORN - HENRY FORD MUSEUM & GREENFIELD VILLAGE

Welcome to Dearborn, hometown of Henry Ford and the Ford Motor Company. Visit the Henry Ford Museum and Greenfield Village for an experience in living history and learn how the automobile forever changed American life and society. At Greenfield Village, take in the historic homes and see the workshops where famous American icons like the Wright Brothers, Thomas Edison, Henry Ford and Robert Frost were once inspired.

Later enjoy the Ford Rouge Factory Tour, an experience housed within Ford Motor Company's Dearborn Truck Plant and real working factory. Get an inside look at the most iconic moments of American manufacturing history and immerse yourself in modern manufacturing's most progressive concepts. The evening is at your leisure. DAY 3: DEARBORN - FRANKENMUTH

Today we travel to the quaint town of Frankenmuth, or as the locals call it, "Little Bavaria," because of its Franconian-style architecture. Enjoy a Frankenmuth area city tour and also visit Bronner's, the largest Christmas store in the world. Later check into your hotel in Frankenmuth for an overnight stay. Dinner is included this evening.

DAY 4: FRANKENMUTH - MACKINAC ISLAND

Depart Frankenmuth and travel to Mackinac Island. Board your ferry to cross the Straits of Mackinac that will take you back to a simpler time where horses replace automobiles. Arrive on Mackinac Island, a natural gem with over eighty percent of its land preserved by Mackinac State Park, extensive woodlands with limestone formations. The island itself is a National Historic Landmark. Check into your hotel for a two-night stay. Dinner and the evening are yours to enjoy.

DAY 5: MACKINAC ISLAND TOUR -GRAND HOTEL LUNCH

Climb aboard your horse-drawn carriage for an island tour that includes stops at the Surrey Hills Carriage Museum and Arch Rock. Next, visit the famous Grand Hotel, a gorgeous and glorious Victorian-era resort and a National Historic Landmark. Enjoy lunch at the hotel's 'Grand Buffet', a bountiful display of incredible food and lavish desserts offering a fusion of tradition and innovation. Following lunch, you can enjoy the brilliant views from the hotel while sitting on the world's longest porch overlooking the Straits of Mackinac or take a walk downtown to visit the shops and buy some fudge and souvenirs. DAY 7: CHICAGO
