6:00 a.m. Motor coach departs from the Town Common Parking Lot (142 Middlesex Ave.) for the trip south to Falmouth, MA. Breakfast snacks may be purchased aboard the ferry.

8:45 a.m. Board the Island Queen for your trip to Martha's Vineyard.

9:00 a.m. Relax on your 35 minute trip across Nantucket Sound to the Vineyard. While on the ferry, you can purchase tickets for a 2 ½ hour bus tour of the Vineyard. You will see miles of beaches, sand dunes and fishing villages from another century. Once on the Island you can rent cars and bikes. Taxi and bus services are available. Shuttle bus service is available to visit

Edgartown, Vineyard Haven or Gay Head.

9:35 a.m. Arrive in Oak Bluffs.

3:30 p.m. Arrive at the dock area in **Oak Bluffs** to board the **Island Queen** for your return trip to Falmouth. Ferry departs at 3:45 p.m. sharp.
