The developer of the Green Meadow Drive subdivision, Joe Langone, requested that the Planning Board review the street acceptance plan for Green Meadow Drive and initiate the street acceptance process.

At their January 2, 2024 meeting, the Planning Board reviewed the attached street acceptance plan and memo from the Town Engineer and voted 4-0 to recommend the Select Board initiate the street acceptance process for Green Meadow Drive and also recommended laying out the public way.

Attached you will find the developer's request, street acceptance plan, and the memo from the Town Engineer. A draft deed has been provided and will be reviewed by staff and Town Counsel.

The Planning Board requests that the Select Board schedule a meeting to initiate the street acceptance process and schedule a subsequent public hearing to layout the way and endorse the street acceptance plan mylar.


The Engineering Division has received a letter from Northeastern Development Corp., dated December 15, 2023, requesting the Town initiate the street acceptance process for Green Meadow Drive. The Engineering Division has also received a stamped As-built Plan and a stamped Street Acceptance Plan (both dated October 31, 2022), in acceptable format. As a reminder, Green Meadow Drive is a twenty-six (26) lot subdivision approved by the Planning Board through the Definitive Subdivision Control process in c.2016.


The Engineering Division performed a final site observation of Green Meadow Drive on December 29, 2023 and find the roadway has been completed in accordance with the approved definitive subdivision design plans. Further, records indicate that the final coarse of pavement was installed in September 2022; thus the 18-month waiting period will elapse well before Town meeting vote in May 2024. The only remaining punch list item for Engineering Division to coordinate with the developer is to perform final maintenance (mowing, sediment and debris removal) of the two (2) stormwater basins prior to Town Meeting in May 2024.

Pursuant to the street acceptance process, the Planning Board shall issue a report to the Select-Board prior to their [Select-Board] consideration to lay out Green Meadow Drive as a public way. After review of the documentation, and having performed a final site observation in December 2023, the Engineering Division recommends that Green Meadow Drive be laid out as a public way.

The Town is currently holding 10% (or \$37,123.00) of the original bond as surety, which will be held by the Town for up to 18 months from substantial completion or until the Street is accepted by the Town.
