NOTIFICATION OF UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION

Butters Row Bridge Construction – Schedule Update

Please be advised that the Town of Wilmington received notification from the Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) that the replacement of the Butters Row Bridge is scheduled to resume in May 2024. This project is being funded and managed by MassDOT. The project is expected to be a multi-year project, including existing bridge demolition, utility work, roadway work, and new bridge construction. MassDOT provided a preliminary schedule for the project (see below). Please note that these dates and construction tasks are tentative and are subject to change as construction progresses:

Tentative Dates	Construction Task
March 2024 – July 2025	Initial Utility Work
May 2024 – June 2025	Initial/Light Construction Prep Work
June 2024 – July 2024	Wetland Resource Area Work
August 2025	Bridge Closure and Detour
September 2025	Existing Bridge Demolition
March 2026 – September 2026	Wall Construction
June 2026 – June 2027	New Bridge Construction
May 2027 – September 2027	Final Utility Work
July 2027 – October 2027	Final Roadway Work
April 2028 – June 2028	Project Completion

Residents will have access to their properties throughout construction, although there will be short delays and/or detours to accommodate workers and public safety.
