



Governor Charlie Baker has ordered that the United States of America flag and the Commonwealth of Massachusetts flag be lowered to half-staff from sunrise until sunset on Thursday, November 19, the day of interment, in honor of Chief Warrant Officer 2 Marwan Sameh Ghabour, US Army, a native of Arlington, Massachusetts, who

passed away on November 12, 2020 in Sinai Peninsula, Egypt. Warrant Officer Ghabour will be laid to rest at the Cedar Knoll Cemetery in East Taunton, Massachusetts.

Chief Warrant Officer 2 Marwan S. Ghabour was one of five U.S. Army soldiers who died in a helicopter crash in Egypt Nov. 12.

Ghabour grew up in Arlington and graduated from Arlington High School in 2010. He was a member of the soccer and wrestling teams and worked as a high school intern for ACMi, Arlington's local access television station.
