Leaders plan, lead, and implement programs and experiences for children in small and large group settings.

The Playground Program will operate Monday through Friday from June 24 - July 31, no July 4, with staff on site from 8:15 a.m. - 1:15 p.m. Playground Leaders must be available to work all days of the program.

Working under the direction and supervision of the Playground Directors, duties include, but are not limited to, leading various physical and non-physical activities and enforcing the Playground program rules.
