

CANDY RAFFLE CONGRATULATIONS TO PAT MCKENNA!


There were 83 candies in the jar. Pat guessed closest with 82.

The permits have been received from the state regarding access from Main Street (Route 38). The interior walls will be installed in May followed by the roof trusses. Weekly on-site construction meetings are being held, which Terri Marciello attends.
