ABOUT THE PROPERTY

Created by a Town Meeting vote in 1975, and transferred to the care, custody, management and control of the Conservation Commission in 1985, the Town Forest is the largest conservation land in Wilmington. It is also one of the few areas of upland protected for passive recreation. The property contains the highest point in town with sweeping views of Boston and surrounding communities. A variety of wildlife inhabit the mixed hardwood forest and the hilltop is an excellent spot for bird watching.

ACCESS & PARKING

Two Main trail access and parking area on Andover Street. Additional trail points from Ballardvale Street and Research Drive.
