RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR HYDRANT USE

1. All hydrant use requires a permit.
2. Hydrant use requires 24 hours notice.
3. Operation of hydrants or valves will be performed by Water Department personnel only.
4. All fees for hydrant use must be paid prior to approval.
5. Fees will not be refunded unless 24 hours notice is given.
6. No fire flow tests will be conducted from November 15 to April 15. Exceptions to this rule can be made based on weather and location.
7. No fire flow hydrant permits will be issued during drought periods or water supply emergencies as determined by the Water and Sewer Superintendent.
8. A copy of the certified flow test results will be forwarded to the Water and Sewer Division.
9. Pools will be filled only for residences not supplied by Town water. The owner will supply all hose and fittings to connect to hydrant.
10. Permits may be denied or revoked by the DPW Director for violation of the Departments rules and regulations.
